



Tournament COVID Considerations

Players must arrive with their own masks. They will be worn at four times: temperature check, with the starter, if players enter the clubhouse/pro shop (bathroom), and at scoring. At all other times, without masks, players must maintain at least 6 feet of separation.

Arrival-

- With mask on, player should report to the range/course no more than 40 minutes prior to tee time. There is no range availability at Meadia Heights. They will need to have their temperature scanned by a LCJGT representative. If it is 100.4 degrees or higher, or they are sick, they must go home.
- Social distance on the range, no masks required.
- Report to the putting green 20 minutes prior to tee time. Only the group "on deck" may be on the putting green.
- Report to the starter after the prior group leaves the tee. Players must wear their masks. Unlike in other years, pencils, sharpies for marking your ball, and tees will NOT be available. Remember not to shake hands at the beginning of the round or after the round.
- Any time anyone enters a building they must wear their mask.

Spectators-

- There will be no spectators for at least the first two events.

- Parents may remain on property, but may not go on to any part of the course. (putting green, range, or golf course)
- Please do not congregate inside the proshop or restaurant.

Scoring-

- After the round, players will need to wear a mask and head to the scoring area to meet with one adult.
- Players will review scores and any rules issues.
- Players will not sign scorecards.
- When the card is left at the scoring table it is considered signed and attested.
- Players should then leave the property. There will not be any in person announcements of winners on tournament day.
- This year there will not be trophies awarded to the winners. We will mail the gift card/certificates to winners.

Water-

- Players should arrive with drinking water.
- We will provide additional drinking water during the round, but will be somewhat limited in distribution. Water will be in bottles and handed out by an adult wearing a mask and gloves. Therefore, access to water may be limited to once or twice during the round. *There will not be coolers placed around the course for self-service. Plan ahead!*

Rules-

- If a player needs a ruling and there isn't a rules official present, they should text or call 717-371-4073 with the hole number and name of the player.

- Flagsticks shall not be intentionally removed. If the flagstick is **intentionally** removed the player will incur a **one stroke penalty**. Inadvertent removal or touching of the flagstick will not incur a penalty. Flagsticks may be straightened using a putter, gloved hand or towel. (See local rules)
- Bunkers will be played as follows: LCJGT will play lift, clean and place in all bunkers - 1 club length no closer to the hole. The ball must remain in the bunker. Players may not smooth the bunker before placing. As always, the player has the option of playing the ball as it lies. We ask all players to smooth their damage in a bunker as much as possible after playing out of the bunker. (See local rules)
- Weather- If there is a weather delay, players must return to their cars to wait for play to resume. Due to COVID, we will likely be quicker to end an event due to severe weather.

We are doing what we can to safely hold tournaments. These guidelines meet PA/CDC standards. However, we reserve the right to change these guidelines/rules if the situation demands or Federal/State guidelines change.

Any participation in the tournament, use of the golf course, facilities at Meadia Heights Golf Course, or attendance at the LCJGT Furyk Family Major may expose you to COVID-19.

Your decision to participate in any way in the tournament is made knowingly and voluntarily by you with full knowledge of this risk. Otherwise, your participation in any way in the tournament shall constitute a waiver and release of Lancaster County Junior Golf Tour, its officers, directors, employees, contractors, volunteers, staff and agents from any and all liability with respect to exposure of the COVID-19.
